## Progress on Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP)

- Buckland Mils had our recent Beginning of Year (BOY) CIP meeting in November 2023.
- BMES 2023-2024 CIP Goals are as follows:
  - o SOL Goals

- 25% or more of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score pass advance on the Reading SOL
- 33% or more of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score pass advance on the Math SOL
- 30% or more of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score pass advance on the Science SOL

### Unit Assessment Goals

- 25% or more of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score 90% or higher on each reading unit assessment.
- 33% or more of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score 90% or higher on each math unit assessment.
- 30% or more of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score 90% or higher on each science unit assessment.
