## **Progress on Continuous Improvement Plan Presentation**

### Learning and Achievement for AI

- 100% of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students with disabilities will score 60% or higher on each HMH selection quiz.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5 selection quizzes given, 57.95% of SWD
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – 6 selection quizzes given, 70.67% of SWD
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – 5 selection quizzes given, 74.8% of SWD
- 65% or more of EL students will score on or above on the HMH Growth measure; MOY: 58%
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – 53.6%
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – 59.1%,
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – 40%
- 60% or more of students with disability scoring proficient and mastery on each unit assessment.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – No Data for SWD
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – Data: 60%
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – Fraction Computation: 76.9%
- 70% or more of ELL students scoring proficient and mastery on each unit assessment.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – Unit 4: Place value, addition and subtraction of whole numbers: 32.1%
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – Data: 70%
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – Fraction Computation: 64.5%
- MOY: 83% or more of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score mastery or proficient on each unit assessment.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> - Earth/Moon/Sun:82.1% and Weather: 72.4%
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – Matter: 72%, Motion: 92.2%, and Energy and Earth's Processes: 78.7%

### Positive Climate and Culture

- 80% or higher positive response on school survey of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students (Oct/Jan)
  - o January survey data – 72.2% of 3-5 grade students responded positively.
    - Slight increase since the beginning of the year
    - 'Keys of Conflict' have had a positive impact on resolving behavior concerns

### Family and Community Engagement

- 80% or more families will respond positively to school survey (Oct/Jan)
  - o Mid-Year Survey Results
    - Do you have a better understanding of homework expectations for your student? Yes 84%, No 16%
    - Are you satisfied with current homework expectations? Yes 67%, No 33%
    - Do you have a better understanding of student choice? Yes 67%, No 33%
    - Are you satisfied with the current student choice opportunities at BMES? Yes 63%, No 37%.
    - This data shows a significant increase in parent understanding of these questions compared to what was collected at the start of the school year.
